WHAT RELAXATION MEASURES MEAN FOR THE OPERNHAUS ZÜRICH

The positive epidemiological developments with regard to the new coronavirus in Switzerland mean closures and distancing requirements for theaters can be relaxed. In its 27 May 2020 decision, the Swiss Federal Council permitted events with a maximum of 300 people. Beginning 6 June 2020, theater performances and concerts will again be possible, under certain conditions.

These relaxation measures will allow the Opernhaus Zürich to resume rehearsals and performances in a reduced form, and in strict compliance with hygiene and distancing regulations, before the summer break. The Opernhaus Zürich will provide information regarding program planning for the rest of the current season as soon as possible.

«The last few weeks and months have made us all painfully aware of how important personal encounters are, and how much we in the theater have missed direct contact with our audience. We are therefore very pleased about the relaxation measures and the newly-won opportunities to meet our Zurich audience in person again in the current season, with a program adapted to the situation.»
